Household Trash Collection and Recycling

Regular household trash and recyclable items may be brought to the township building on the first and third Saturday of each month between 7:30 a.m. and noon. Use of the dumpster at any other time is not permitted unless prior arrangements have been made with the Township Office.

Disposal fees per bag are as follows:

- ◆ Tall Kitchen Bags (13-16 gal) - \$2
- ◆ Regular Trash Bags (30-45 gal) - \$3
- ◆ Heavy Duty Trash Bags (55+ gal) - \$4

Recyclable items do not need to be sorted, but items do need to be thrown individually into the recycling trailer. Please do not throw bags or boxes of recyclable items into the trailer. Also, it is imperative that you rinse out any food remains and crush each item. Any containers or boxes, including pizza boxes, with any food or grease residue should not be thrown into the recycling bin. Items accepted for recycling include metal and aluminum cans, plastics #1 through #7, and just about anything made from paper or cardboard. Glass is not accepted for recycling. Bulky Trash Collection Days

Letterkenny Township’s Annual Bulky Trash Collection Days will be held on Friday, May 5, and Saturday, May 6, from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. Bulky trash items will be accepted at the township building with township personnel available to unload your items. Most bulky items are accepted, but we cannot accept batteries, chemicals, dehumidifiers, fluorescent lights, motor oil, wet paint cans, propane tanks, or yard waste. We will be accepting TVs, monitors, computers, and other electronic items. **There will be a disposal fee of 50 cents per pound for electronic items.** We will also accept 4 tires (16” or less) per household for free. Additional tires have a disposal fee of \$2 per tire. Truck tires are \$10 per tire, and tractor tires are \$25 per tire. Tires must be separated from the rims. Please be prepared for fees with cash or a check made payable to Letterkenny Township. This is the only time of the year that we can accept large items, tires, or electronic items.
