## Mandatory Pumping

Township Ordinance 2007-1 states that all residences in Letterkenny Township that are not connected to public sewer must have their septic tanks pumped once every three years. If you reside in Letterkenny East (residences with a Chambersburg address), you may be due to have your septic tank pumped this year. Any tank pumped in 2020 is now due to be pumped again. Please contact the township office if you are unsure of the date that your septic tank was last pumped. Thank you for your cooperation.

## Inclement Weather Rules

Please do not park along the road during inclement weather and be aware of the following declarations. Neither the Township nor its snow plow drivers will be responsible for:

-damage to vehicles parked along the road. If vehicles are parked along a road, that road may not be plowed.

-damage to mailboxes due to heavy snow coming off the plow as opposed to contact with the plow.

-damage to yards that do not have snow stakes marking the boundary.



## Horse Valley Area Addresses

The Letterkenny Township administration is working alongside the Franklin County Planning Commission to assign street numbers to properties in the Horse Valley area that currently do not have a street address. There are many seasonal cabins and outbuildings that do not have an assigned street address and this makes locating one of these properties very difficult in the event of an emergency, such as a fire or medical need. Our goal is for every property that has any type of structure on the premise to have a numbered street address and not just a street name for the location. This would include seasonal cabins and trailers, most importantly, as well as any outbuildings, garages, storage sheds, pavilions, etc.



You will be notified via your mailing address if your seasonal property is assigned a location address. If you are not assigned an address by the end of summer and would like one, feel free to contact the township office. It is possible that a few addresses will need to be changed in order for all addresses to be chronologically accurate.

It would be helpful if your street number would be posted at the end of the driveway or on the building if it is visible from the road. If you would like to order a sign like the one shown here, contact the Pleasant Hall Vol Fire Co or pick up an order form at the township building.

## Summer Road Projects

### **2022**

-The section of Funk Road between Rocky Spring Road and Lawyer Road was paved.  
-Iron Bridge and Limekiln Roads were double seal coated, extending the life of the roads.

### **2023**

-Thanks to the Conservation District's Dirt, Gravel, and Low Volume Road Grant, a layer of Driving Surface Aggregate (DSA) will be added to Carrick Road and the unpaved portion of Upper Horse Valley Road near the St. Thomas Township line.  
-All roads in and around Kensington Heights and the Foothills of Kensington will be double seal coated.
